Our internet broadcasting (streaming) is now a reality. Thanks to hard work by our technology team, Chad, Fritz, Jonathan, Kent, and Noah, the equipment is installed, and we are online. We are staking out a corner of the internet so that the glory of our Lord is seen by others throughout the world. This is a tool by which we reach others. Last Sunday morning, 93 people visited our live broadcast including some international visitors. Most of that was probably out of curiosity, but it does demonstrate the reach of the internet and the importance of claiming a spot for Jesus.

## You can help by sharing

If you have a Facebook account, please “like” our church page. This will ensure that you will see messages we post including upcoming broadcasts. Then, share the posts to your page. This will make sure that your friends and followers will see the same post.

You can also share by telling your friends, family, and neighbors about the broadcast. They can go to our website, [easternshorechurch.com](http://easternshorechurch.com), and then clicking on the appropriate link (it's the first article below the banners) to view the live broadcast and the archives.

## You can help by singing

We have added audience microphones that do a better job of broadcasting the singing of the assembly and reducing the sound of the song leader. We need to sing out with joy and enthusiasm. The churches of Christ follow a Biblical pattern of singing without added mechanical instruments. We should be the best singers in the religious world. Even if you think you are without singing talent, your voice will blend into the lovely voices of your brethren.

This is not a show or performance for the internet. It is simply genuine worship which happens to be available for viewing. Those who are ill and infirm will be watching and joining with us in worship. Those displaced because of work or service often find themselves without a church assembly to meet. They will watch and worship. Many will use the broadcast as a way to check us out before coming in person. Consider your own habits. Don't you visit the internet to check out travel spots, hotels, attractions or even churches before you visit? People in our community will do the same. Let them see real worship.

## You can help by monitoring

If you notice that something is not working, let us know *after* worship. There is not much that can be done during worship to fix problems. Those working in the booth are also worshipping. We've automated as much of the process as possible so they will not be distracted. Please don't call or text during the worship but do let us know later so we can fix the problem. Also, as a personal favor, please don't mention it to me just before the worship. I need that time to focus on our guests and what I am preaching.

## You can help by greeting

We expect visits to increase over time. You do such a fine job greeting our guests. Remember, they chose to hear instead of somewhere else. Make sure they know they are appreciated. Last week a guest commented that we were one of the friendliest churches that had visited in their travels. What a great compliment! Keep doing what you are doing by welcoming and encouraging every guest that comes through.
