2022 Summer Registration is now open for the week of **June 26th—July 1st.**



Part 1: What is a Christian?

What is a Christian, you ask? Good question. Once no one asked such a question because it seemed obvious. But today, with many counterfeit faiths, it's harder than ever to define, let alone identify a Christian. We will give you an answer from the Bible. All we can know about true Christians we find in Scripture.

The Bible first uses the word "Christian" to describe the disciples of Jesus in Antioch (Acts 11:26). Surprisingly, we only find "Christian" two more times in the Bible. King Agrippa spoke of being persuaded to become a Christian (Acts 26:28), and Peter speaks of the suffering Christian (1 Peter 4:16), but "disciple" is the name of Jesus' followers in most cases.

A disciple is a follower, one who attaches himself to another and learns his ways and teachings. He submits to the teacher

Submission is a key characteristic of any Christian. One who refuses to submit to *all* the teachings of our Lord should not be called a Christian. Many give Jesus some, but not all of themselves. Consider the Lord's own words in Mark. "*If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me*" (Mark 8:34). A Christian must deny himself and his desires and wants and follow after Jesus. In fact, the Christian must follow Jesus even unto his own death (Mark 8:35; Revelation 2:10). This is serious. Jesus said in Matthew 10:37, 38.

Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. And whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me.

In John 6:66, many disciples left Jesus because they would not accept the totality of his teachings. It's clear: one who clings to anything more than Jesus is not worthy.

What is a Christian? A Christian follows Jesus completely.

In John 13, Jesus washed the disciple's feet. It was an object lesson of servitude that the Lord taught his followers (John 13:12-15).

When he had washed their feet and put on his outer garments and resumed his place, he said to them, "Do you understand what I have done to you? You call me Teacher and Lord, and you are right, for so I am. If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that you also should do just as I have done to you.

A true follower of Jesus – a true Christian -- would learn this lesson of humility and service and would quickly duplicate the Lord's example in his own life. Jesus taught another, more sweeping lesson that he couched as a command (John 14:15). "If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

This command would be the identifying characteristic of Jesus' disciples (John 13:35).

By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

What is a Christian? A Christian is one who loves like Jesus. That's how we can identify disciples of our Lord. Jesus' love is unconditional. It is sacrificial. His love is not contingent on performance or what you can do for him. He loved us first (1 John 4:19)
